Numerous career paths exist at Dairyland Power Cooperative

Power Plant Positions

Plant Operations

Operate and maintain surveillance on plant equipment such as boilers, turbines, generators and auxiliary equipment. Associate degree in electrical, instrument, mechanical or power plant field is required for the operator positions.

Electrician and Electrician Trainee

Repair, maintain and troubleshoot the plant's electrical systems. This position requires a minimum of an Associate degree or two-year diploma in an electrical related field.

Instrument Technicians and Trainee

Repair, maintain and troubleshoot the plant's instrumentation system. This position requires a minimum of an Associate degree or two-year diploma in an instrument related field.

Mechanic and Mechanic Trainee

Repair, test and maintain all plant systems and equipment. This position requires an Associate degree or two-year diploma in a mechanical related field.

Performance Technician and Trainee

Obtain needed plant performance and efficiency data as well as, perform laboratory analysis,

plant performance analysis, and plant computer reliability functions. Associate degree in a directly related field is required for this position.

Coal Handler

Provide for the safe unloading and transporting of coal and yard activities to support load demand and generation requirements. This position requires a related vo-tech diploma plus two (2) years trade-related experience **OR** high school diploma plus four (4) years trade-related experience (plant maintenance/ operation, coal handling, barge unloading, or heavy equipment).



Power Delivery Positions

Lineworker

Assist in construction, repair, and operation of the transmission system (transmission lines and substations). High school diploma and completion of a recognized accredited lineworkers' program.

Electrician

Perform test, diagnostics, repair, maintenance and construction functions for substations and other equipment. High school diploma and completion of a four-year electrician apprentice program required for this position.

Administration

Accounting/Finance

Dairyland has many positions in the finance and accounting area. Educational background necessary for these positions are an associate degree or higher in an accounting or business related field.

Engineers

Dairyland employs engineers in many areas of the company. Typical disciplines include electrical and mechanical engineers. Degree is required, power options are beneficial.

Information Technology

Positions include programmers, system support and help desk. Education requirements typically required for these positions include associate or bachelor's degree in a computer related field.

Office

Dairyland employs many support positions such as Administrative secretaries, administrative assistants and administrative specialists. Vocational school or associate degree is required for these positions.
